Don't schedule more than two tests on any given day. Choose subjects you are confident in. Give yourself time to take these three tests twice if need be before mid December of your senior year. Schools only count your highest score, so finding where you are and giving yourself time to retake if need be is a plus. In addition to the resources above, Kaplan has good SAT preparation books that you may choose to use.	High

October 1 Sr. Year	Begin College Applications	Apply to at least two schools that meet/stretch your goals and have great financial packages as well as at least one safe school. Your desired course of study should be considered when choosing schools. When writing for college applications and scholarships, start early and rewrite, edit, edit, and re-edit. Have several good writers review your work. Then rewrite and polish it again. You can use https://drive.google.com/ to allow several people to work on a piece simultaneously and discuss edits in real time.	High
